Spring Term 2022 Frozen Planet



Our place in the world. Learning for life. Inspired learners.

English

This term our key texts will be:

- Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers
- Non-Fiction books about the explorer Captain Scott
- Stories from different cultures including Ice Bear by Nicola Davies and The Emperors Egg by Martin Jenkins

Our focus continues to be on sentence structure and using different types of sentences with the correct punctuation as well as thinking about our setting descriptions. We will be developing our vocabulary through guided reading sessions which will allow the children the ability to choose a range of words in their writing, making it more exciting to read. The children will also be looking at writing non-chronological reports about penguins or Captain Scott. We will use lots of drama, role play and speaking and listening activities in talk for writing to help develop our ideas and understanding of the text we are learning about.

We will produce writing in the following genres:

- Recounts
- Narrative
- Non- Chronological reports

Science

Our topic is 'animals and their habitas'

We will be looking at animals needs for survival, living things and their habitats and exploring and comparing living, dead and things that have never been alive.

Computing

This term we will be focusing on:

- Creating digital artwork
- Researching online
- Naming components of computers including input and output devices

Maths

Our maths topics this term are:

- Addition and subtraction (Year 1 and 2)
- Multiplication and division (Year 2)
- Statistics (Year 2)
- Shape (Year 2)
- Place Value (Year 1)
- Measurement Length, Height, Weight, Volume (Year 1)

We will continue to develop children's understanding of number, place value and the four operations.

When learning something new we encourage the children to use the CPA approach.

Concrete - using objects and equipment

Pictorial - represent their thinking using pictures Abstract - using numbers and symbols to solve calculations

Tuesday – Dance Thursday – Ball Skills

PSHE - Jigsaw

This term the children will learning about dreams and goals and how to work with others in a team. They will be setting realistic goals and working with others in a team to create an end product. They will be exploring how to share success with others.



Other highlights

History This term, we are learning about significant historical people, specifically Captain Robert Falcon Scott. We will also be looking at changes within living memory and comparing jobs, clothes, school, transport, technology from that time to current day.

Geography This term we will be learning about Antarctica and the world's seven continents and five oceans.

Music This term, we will be exploring graphic scores and using these to create our own music. We will also be learning songs to celebrate Spring and Easter.

Science: We will be investigation melting using Ice eggs!

Art and Design The children will be exploring sketching and follow steps to draw a penguin. They will also have an opportunity to create a penguin sculpture using clay.
