If you have a safeguarding or child protection concern:

Step 1: Complete a Part 1 Concern Form. Available on the staffroom noticeboard or you can obtain a copy from the DSL or office.

Step 2: Give the Part 1 Concern Form to the DSL.

Step 3: You must ensure the DSL completes the Part 2 and feeds back to you. Part 2 should include a risk assessment.

In the absence of the DSL please hand the form to and discuss your concerns with one of the **Deputy Designated Safeguarding Leads: Emma Hopkins or Rebecca** Stender.

If DSL or the DDSLs are not available to speak, the office will contact them.

If a child is in immediate danger, you must call 999.

Other source of help: Contact the NSPCC Helpline on <u>0808 800 5000</u> or by emailing <u>help@nspcc.org.uk</u>. Their trained professionals will talk through your concerns with you, give you expert advice and take action to protect the child as appropriate. This may include making a referral to the local authority. If you have a FGM concern you must also report this to the Police call 101.
