## What You Must Know!

#### **Student Security**

It is everyone's responsibility to ensure that all persons on site are safe at all times. Please keep this leaflet with you and always ask a member of staff if anything is not clear.

### First Aid

If you or a pupil needs first aid or anyone is unwell, please come to Reception where a First Aider will be called. Alternatively, please ask the nearest staff member to call for help.

#### Photography

Taking photographs on site or making recordings is strictly forbidden without prior authorisation from the Headteacher, Will McDonald.

#### **Health and Safety**

Contractors and visitors must ensure they are fully conversant with the safety rules and guidelines/regulations to be observed. They should be followed at all times. This is a requirement of the Health and Safety at Work Act.

#### **Smoking and Vaping**

Thakeham Primary School is a designated no smoking and vaping site. It is strictly forbidden and should not take place on site, in the carpark or in the layby.

#### Fire, lockdown and Evacuation

Fire: a continuous alarm. Upon hearing, leave by the nearest exit, find a member of staff and they will escort you to our assembly point on the playground. Do not re-enter the building until told it is safe to do so. Lockdown: a whistle will sound three times followed by the phrase, 'lockdown'. Please move into the nearest room, lock the door and wait until the all-clear.

### Safeguarding

This is always our number one priority. Our staff are highly trained in line with Keeping Children Safe in Education. Every public area in the school has a poster detailing DSL names and contact information – also for the LADO and other agencies. Pupils are highly aware of where to go when they need help. If you have a concern, you can pick up a form from the office or talk to the DSLs.
