We were delighted to welcome Michael Rosen (virtually) to our classes on 1st July. The children really enjoyed joining in with all the actions and watching his animated expressions as he spoke. He answered questions from the children about being a poet and where his inspiration for his poetry came from. Beth, in year 6, even had the opportunity to perform her own Eddie story poem to him and he gave her invaluable feedback to allow her to continue to grow as a poet. FOTS Fundraisers and treats

This week FOTS are collecting unwanted clothes as part of the Bags2School scheme to raise funds for the school. They are also collecting as previously advertised, books, DVS, CDs, games consoles and Lego (subject to the conditions as set out on the flyer at the end of this newsletter and as previously advertised). Parents can drop off these items at the beginning/end of the day at the following times:

Monday 12th July: Acorns & Oak; Tuesday 13th July: Maple; Thursday 15th July: Elder

The front staff/visitor car park will be available for parents on these classes for the purpose of dropping of items on the days listed above. Please drive safely in and out and be mindful of pedestrians. Please do not use the car park at any other time or if you are not dropping items to be re-cycled. Thank you for your full cooperation.

FOTS are also kindly providing the end of year 6 pizza and ice-cream treat which we are very grateful for.

Traffic Issues

Over the past term, we have seen the area around the car park become much safer at drop off/collection times and have appreciated your support in this. We are however becoming increasingly concerned at the traffic situation that has developed in the coach bay area. With parents double parking in this area and mounting the pavement it is becoming difficult for both pedestrians to walk safely along the footpath and for other vehicle users to pass through, especially coaches.

A reminder that this area is a drop-off zone only and should only be used for Elder class drop off/pick up. Please do not park on the pedestrian pathways and only park on the left hand side of this area, do not park on the other side too, thereby restricting access for other vehicles, especially coaches and emergency vehicles. We are very lucky to be able to access around 60 spaces in the SGS car park next door, even when it is raining please use these spaces to park. Vehicles should not be left unattended in the drop off area. We will ask you to move your vehicle if these rules are not followed, your full co-operation is essential.

Covid-19 Update

As you will be aware, the government is set to move to stage 4 from 19th July easing restrictions (confirmation due today). With the backing of government and WSCC (see separate letter from Paul Wagstaff Director of Education and Skills) we will continue with our risk assessment until the end of term. We have reinvented the school and its system of controls many times over the past 18 months and will not be implementing significant changes for the last 5 days of term. We are mindful that the number of cases locally have increased significantly over the past 4 weeks causing much disruption and absence. The last thing we want is to increase the risk of an outbreak in the last week of term, which could lead to illness and disruption at the start of the summer holidays.

The only changes we will be implementing for the last week of term will be:

- to allow 2 adults per Year 6 child to attend the 'Leavers Assembly' (outside) on Friday 23rd September at 9am. In the case of inclement weather we will hold this in the hall (face coverings will be requested and windows/doors will be open)
- to support internal transition on Wednesday 21st July.

From 19th July close contacts of cases will be identified by NHS Test and Trace rather than schools (though schools may be contacted by NHS). If a child or anyone in the household/childcare bubble experiences Covid-19 symptoms, the rules of self-isolation for the whole-household/childcare/support bubble will remain in place. However from 16th August children under the age of 18 will not be required to self-isolate if deemed a close contact but will be advised to take a PCR test by NHS Test and Trace.

If a child presents as having Covid-19 symptoms whether this term or when we return after the break, they will be required to be collected, a PCR test should be booked and they should self-isolate until a negative PCR result has been returned; or self-isolate for 10 days after the first day of symptoms if positive.

From September 2021

We hope to reinstate whole-school assemblies, events, educational visits and dispel 'bubbles.' Face coverings will be optional (unless dealing with a suspected case when full PPE should be worn).

The following measures will need to be maintained:

- Supporting good hand hygiene—regular handwashing/sanitising; good respiratory hygiene—promoting the message of 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it'
- Enhanced cleaning of key touchpoints
- Ventilation of rooms wherever practical
- Following PHE advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of Covid-19

Information on arrangements for the start/end of the day e.g. timings etc will be communicated shortly.

Free School Meals Summer Holiday Vouchers

Children eligible for Free School Meals eligible will be entitled to a £15.00 voucher per child per week to cover the six-week school summer holiday period. We are due to receive the vouchers from Monday 12th July to Friday 23rd July (this will be via Edenred as before).

Holiday Activity and Food Programme (HAF)

West Sussex County Council have also received funding to deliver the Governments Holiday Activity and Food Programme (HAF). This programme provides activities and food nutrition education, as well as a meal to those who attend. WSCC Community Hub

About the session:


