#### **Christmas Nativities and Services**

Acorn and Oak class have begun rehearsing separate Nativities this year, for Covid reasons. Year 1 and 2 are also preparing their performance in separate sections, to enable the children to sing, in line with our risk assessment. Once again, we are very sad you won't be able to join us this year, but we will be recording the performances and making these available to you before we break up for the holiday.

KS2 children would normally celebrate Christmas at St Mary's Church, Thakeham with a beautiful carol service. This year Maple and Elder will be presenting their own festive celebration, which we will record and make available to you electronically before the Christmas break. Rev'd Sara-Jane will be visiting key stage assemblies in December to support us with celebrating this very special time of year.
