We have revised the start of the day, 8:40am gates open; 8:45 children enter school. We will have zones for children to line up in (either myself or Mrs Hopkins will be on duty):

- Elder: top playground (independently without a parent/carer), parents to wait outside along the fence.
- Maple: last third of the playground (near the front of the school with the blue canopy); parents are welcome to 'drop and go' from 8:40am (no earlier) or can wait to the side in this area.
- Oak children: to line up in the same place they are currently. Parents to wait to one side in this area.
- Acorns: to line up with their parent outside Acorn gate with their parents.

Arrangements for the end of day are Acorns to leave at 3:10pm once on full days and all other classes at 3:15pm. Parents to wait in the class areas indicated above. Elder parents please wait outside along the playground fence.

The West Sussex County Council Bikeability team will be running Bikeability activity sessions this summer in partnership with our catering provider, Monster Foods.

Children will be given the opportunity to take part in a **Bikeability Level 1 and 2 Training Course** at **St Wilfrid's school in Crawley** as part of the **Holidays Activity and Food programme** (HAF).

Important note: All course inductees must be over the age of 10 years old and have a reasonable level of bicycle control skills prior to attending including making the cycle go where they want, cycling with one hand and looking behind. Training will take place on single lane public roads with a moderate flow of traffic.

Courses will be run over four days between the following dates:

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August 2<sup>nd</sup> – August 5<sup>th</sup>
August 9<sup>th</sup> – August 12<sup>th</sup>
August 16<sup>th</sup> – August 19<sup>th</sup>
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There will be 2 session options per day and each daily training session will last for 2 hours. Available options:
